PRESCHOOL ~ Our preschoolers will be meeting for their monthly class next weekend, April 21, during regular class time (10:00am to 11:00am).



MONTH 1–"My heart is beating!" ~ Your spiritually adopted baby has been quite active over the past month. Already your baby is 10,000 times bigger than at conception. By the 20th day, your baby has developed a deep neural groove, providing the foundations of his brain, spinal cord, and nervous system. His heart began to beat on the 21st day, pumping blood through his own circulatory system; the baby's blood can be a different blood type than the mother's.

The mother's immune system recognizes that the little one is a different person, which would normally lead her immune system to attack. However, the mother's physiology prevents this so that the baby can continue to grow and develop. During the next month, your spiritually adopted baby is most vulnerable to being aborted. 
