MONTH 3 ~ "I can suck my thumb!" Your spiritually adopted baby is quite active in the womb now – although his mother won't feel him for another couple of months. If his mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby squint, swallow, and move his tongue. He can make a tight fist if you touch his palm. Although he obtains the oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord, he "breathes" in and out the amniotic fluid to help develop his lungs and prepare him to breathe air after birth.

The baby you are praying for weighs approximately one ounce. Early this month – at just 9 weeks – he began to be able to suck his thumb.
